PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11326 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Pendleton of PO Box 190, Pendleton, Oregon, 97801, phone 276-1811, for use of the waters from one well (Well 8),

for the PURPOSE of municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 5, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6.7 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1640 feet South and 47 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 2 Septh, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

The amount of water used for municipal purposes under this right, together with the amount of 1.52 cubic foot per second allowed under the order approving Tranfer 5605 shall be limited to a total of 6.7 cfs.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986. Extended to October 1, 1991

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87. Extended to October 1, 1991
