PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11378** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **James W. Mason, Jr. of Box 8, Lawen, Oregon, 97740, phone 493-2815,**
for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 53.5 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 23, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.67 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **20 feet North and 400 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 32 1/2 East, W4, in the County of Harney.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that although declared herein to be for primary irrigation, the supplemental right allowed under Application 68368, Permit 49406 may, in the interest of conserving the ground water resources, be exercised at times when water is available from ground water provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **August 9, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
