PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11332 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, America of Seattle District, Corps of Engineers of PO Box C-3755, Seattle, Washington, 98124, phone (206)764-3780, for use of the waters from Well 1,

for the PURPOSE of sanitary purposes and maintenance of a fire protection system, being 2800 gallons per day for sanitary purposes and a maximum of 30,000 gpd for maintenance of the fire protection system that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 20, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 25 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1146 feet North and 2168 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South, Range 13 East, WM Section 11 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sanitary purposes and fire protection

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 21, 1986 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
