PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11366** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **The Corporation of the Presiding Bishopric of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints**, a Utah Corporation sole, of 50 E. North Temple Street, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84150, phone (801)531-2929, for use of the waters from Well 1, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 2.0 acres and temperature control in chapel, being 0.05 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.16 cfs for temperature control**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 11, 1985 for 0.025 cfs and June 26, 1985 for 0.185 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.21 cfs**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **524.5 feet North and 507.5 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 36, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided that use of water for temperature control in the chapel in excess of 5000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless the effluent is reinjected to a suitable ground water reservoir or put to a beneficial consumptive use in accordance with OAR 690-65.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **October 21, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**.
