PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11387 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Eagle Crest Partners Ltd. of PO Box 1215, Redmond, Oregon, 97756, phone 923-2453, for use of the waters from two wells, being 195 gallons per minute from Well 1 and 570 gpm from Well 2,

for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 20, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 765 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 150 feet North and 1640 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 14, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14; Well 2 - 500 feet South and 550 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, both in Township 15 South, Range 12 East, WM, in * A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* the County of Deschutes.

Township 15 South, Range 12 East, WM Section 14 SE 1/4 Quasi-municipal Section 13 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24 W 1/2 W 1/2

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 1, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87. Extended to October 1, 1992

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88. Extended to October 1, 1992
