## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11427 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ronald F. or Wanda J. Kasper of Route 2, Box 2235, Bandon, Oregon, 97411, phone 347-2635, for use of the waters from a sump well when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the sump well to be made up by \* for the PURPOSE of temperature control, flood harvesting, and irrigation of 24.0 acres, being 3.6 cfs for temperature control, 1.2 cfs for flood harvesting, and 0.6 cfs for irrigation that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 9, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.6 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Sump - 265 feet North and 1470 feet East; Well 1 - 425 feet North and 1440 feet East; Well 2 - 870 feet North and 1410 feet East, all from the Southwest Corner of Section 4, being within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos. A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost control) on forms furnished.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 16, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
