PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11428 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Philomath Forest Products Co. of PO Box 109, Philomath, Oregon, 97370, phone 929-3205, for use of the waters from three wells,

for the PURPOSE of industrial use in manufacturing facilities (sawmill and planer) for drinking, restrooms, cooling and lubrication of machines, and maintenance of fire protection system

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 12, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30.0 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 183 feet North and 2580 feet West from the Northeast Corner of DLC 72, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12; Well 2 - 432 feet South and 2315 feet West from the Southwest Corner of DLC 72, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12; Well 3 - 536 feet South and 2168 feet West from the *

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Southwest Corner of DLC 72, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, all in Township 12 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
