PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11448** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Blue Mountain Forest Products** by **Bruce Malcom**, President of Box **1161, Pendleton, Oregon, 97801**, phone **276-4304**, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of **industrial uses in sawmill (saw lubrication and cooling, log deck sprinkling and cogeneration power plant boiler recharge and cooling water)**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 31, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.0 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **800 feet North and 1250 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 10 South, Range 30 East, WM, in the County of Grant.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South, Range 30 East, WM Section 9 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 General sawmill use
i.e. saw lubrication
and cooling, log
deck sprinkling,
cogeneration power
plant use, boiler
recharge and cooling

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 7, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
