PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11329 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions

This permit is issued to Richard Fulgham of Dixie, Washington, 99329, phone (509)525-5749, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 19.4 acres and supplemental irrigation 158.6 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 10, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.23 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

m The\ well\ is\ to\ be\ LOCATED:}$ 3540 feet North and 15 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 27, being within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 6 North, Range 34 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Supplemental Township 6 North, Range 34 East, WM Section 22 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 10.0 acres Section 27 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 32.2 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 36.4 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 40.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 40.0 acres Primary Section 22 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 8.0 acres Section 27 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 7.8 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 21, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.
