## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11437** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of PO Box 3503, Portland, Oregon, 97208, phone 229-5674, for use of the waters from one well,**

for the PURPOSE of **fish culture**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 24, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **300 gallons per minute**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **35 feet North and 1095 feet East from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 6, being within SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Government Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) Section 6, Township 33 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Curry.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 33 South, Range 14 West, WM Section 6 Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) Fish Culture**

and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others,

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 21, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
