PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11341 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mt. Bachelor, Inc. of 335 SW Century Drive, Bend, Oregon, 97701, phone 382-2442, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 5.0 acres, supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres and commercial uses of water within the Mt. Bachelor complex including three day lodges which contain sanitary facilities and restaurant/snack bars, a maintenance building* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 21, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 110 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 3000 feet North and 2200 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 20, being within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 18 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* and first aid/ski partrol building with sanitary facilities, being 40 gallons per minute for irrigation and 110 gpm for commercial uses

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 21, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
