PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11419** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert E. Rich of 9803 Yergen Road, NE, Aurora, Oregon, 97002, phone 678-2828, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of greenhouse use, containerized nursery stock use and irrigation of 18.2 acres, being 30 gallons per minute for greenhouse use, 85 gpm for containerized nursery stock use, and 85 gpm for irrigation that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 2, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 85.0 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 710 feet South and 565 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 18 being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 4 South, Range 1 West WM., in the county of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 17, 1987 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
