PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11422 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Knappa Water Association, of Route 4, Box 550-K, Astoria, Oregon, phone 458-6461, for use of the waters from four wells, being 90 gallons per minute from Well TW 84-2, and 150 gpm from each of Wells TW 85-1, TW 85-3, and TW 85-4. for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 5, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 540.0 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well TW85-1 - 1450 feet North and 2450 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15; Well TW84-2 - 1275 feet South and 2000 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29; Well TW85-3 - 1850 feet *

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* North and 1800 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 14, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14; Well TW85-4 - 300 feet North and 2100 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 13, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13 all in Township 8 North, Range 7 West, WM, in the county of Clatsop.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 17, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**. ~~Extended to October 1, 1993, 10-1-93~~

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**. ~~Extended to October 1, 1993, 10-1-93~~
