PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11410 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon, 97601, phone 883-6714, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of Chiloquin Ranger Station activities and irrigation of 3.0 acres, being 0.036 cubic foot per second for Ranger Station activities and 0.038 cfs for irrigation of 3.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 9, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.074 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 500 feet North and 1600 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 33, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, Township 34 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South, Range 7 East, WM Section 33 SW 1/4 SW 1/4	0.2 acre irrigation
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	0.4 acre
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	2.4 acres
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	Ranger Station Activities

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to $\frac{1}{80}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
