### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11433 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Don Mills of Mills Mint Farm, Inc. of Route 1, Box 84, Stanfield, Oregon, 97875, phone 449-3312, for use of the waters from one pit well,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 9.25 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 30, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the pit well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 660 feet North and 1350 feet East from the center corner of Section 33, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM Section 27	NE 1/4	NW 1/4	2.5 acres
	NW 1/4	NW 1/4	3.5 acres
	SW 1/4	NW 1/4	3.25 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Use of water under this permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of Stanfield Drain or any tributary thereof; any depletion will require the pit well be shut down, pursuant to the Order of Withdrawal by the Water Resources Commission dated December 2, 1985, in the matter of the withdrawal of certain unappropriated waters of the Umatilla River and tributaries, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
