PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11465 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bonneville Power Administration of PO Box 3621, Portland, Oregon, 97208, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of as a back-up and emergency source for industrial uses which include cooling water and drinking water at the Celilo D.C. Converter Station

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 16, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 500 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1800 feet North and 500 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 6, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 14 East, WM Section 6 W 1/2 SE 1/4 Industrial

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989
