PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11503 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles C. Hart of 16981 Greens Bridge Road SE, Jefferson, Oregon, 97352, phone 327-2540, for use of the waters from Hart Well when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Hart Well to be made up by appropriation * for the PURPOSE of greenhouse use (220,000 square feet)

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 9, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 200 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Hart Well- 240 feet North and 920 feet East from the South quarter corner of Section 7; Smith Well- 660 feet North and 66 feet East from the South quarter corner of Section 7, both being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989
