## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION  $\textbf{G-11488} \quad \text{and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS}$ and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Martin A. and Janet A. Buchanan of Route 4. Milton-Freewater, Oregon, 97862, for use of the waters from two wells,

irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 7.0 acres, being use of for the PURPOSE of water from Well 1 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 1 to be made up by use from Well 2 for irrigation of 3.8 acres and use from \* nat the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 10, 1986 that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.9 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1- 2640 feet South and 1950 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 29; Well 2- 1580 feet South and 580 feet East from the Northwest corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, being within the (Well 1)- SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29; (Well 2)- NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, both in Township 6 North, A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* Well 1 for the supplemental irrigation of 3.2 acres

\*\* Range 36 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 17, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
