PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11512 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Frank Della-Rose, acting for The Mountain View Geothermal Group, 1834 Benson, Klamath Falls, Oregon, 97601, phone 884-1055, for use of the waters from a geothermal well, for the PURPOSE of heating water for eight home sites,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 25, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 90.0 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 174 feet North and 218 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, Township 38 South, Range 9 East, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 20 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Heating water

Provided that use of water for heating in excess of 5000 gallons per day shall be subsequent and inferior to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and maintained and all water wasted from the system recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 28, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
