## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11478 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Seneca, PO Box 208, Seneca, Oregon, 97873, phone 542-2161, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of Municipal,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 21, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 380.0 gallons per minute,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 925 feet South and 625 feet West from the center quarter corner of Section 35, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988. Extended to October 1, 1993, 10-1-93

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989. Extended to October 1, 1993, 10-1-93
