PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11484 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Prairie City Co-Gen Co., Box 386, Prairie City, Oregon, 97869, phone 820-3351, for use of the waters from three wells, and shall be further limited to any deficiency in supply from the John Day River allowed under *

for the PURPOSE of Industrial uses for operation of co-generation power plant (water treatment, gland water, recharge water for boiler, cooling tower and drinking water),

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 18, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 400 gallons per minute,

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well #1- 660 feet South and 1125 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 10; Well #2- 375 feet South and 1060 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 10; Well #3- 775 feet South and 825 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 10, all being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, Township 13 ** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Application 68787, Permit 49760, or to periods of emergency or when flows in the John Day River are turbid,
- ** South, Range 33 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM Section 10 NE1/4 NE1/4 Industrial Uses

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
