### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10957 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Barbara Y. and William J. Bowerman of 33707 McKenzie View Drive, Eugene, Oregon, 97401, phone 726-7116, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 266.1 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 11, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 2600 feet South and 1200 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 16, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 19 East, WM, in the County of Wheeler.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation, the right may be exercised at times the primary source is turbid. The right herein shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **October 21, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1988**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1989**.
