PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11405 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to School District 6 care of Sams Valley Elementary School, 14235 Table Rock Road, Central Point, Oregon, 97502, phone 665-6611 ext. 295, for use of the waters from one well, for the PURPOSE of school uses and to maintain a suitable water condition in sewage lagoon, being 18 gallons per minute for school uses and 12 gpm for maintaining lagoon, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 26, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30 gallons per minute,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1270 feet North and 180 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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| Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 28 | SE1/4 SE1/4 | School uses and to maintain a suitable water condition in sewage lagoon |
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The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
