PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11457 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Spike Ranch, Inc. of Route 1, Box 4, Echo, Oregon, 97826, phone 376-8203, for use of the waters from one sump well,

for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 205.9 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 29, 1985,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.6 cubic foot per second,

measured at the point of diversion from the sump well or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 350 feet North and 3130 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 7, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7, Township 3 North, Range 29 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of the Water Exchange Agreement recorded at pages 1669 through 1675, Volume 6, Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director. Use of water under this permit shall be limited to appropriation only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of Umatilla River or any tributary thereof; any depletion will require the well to be shut down unless the Order of Withdrawal of the Water Resources Commission dated December 2, 1985, is not extended or amended, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
