## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11521 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Randolph S. Carey, Jr. of PO Box 27, Williams, Oregon, 97544, phone 846-6713, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of Supplemental irrigation of 17.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 15, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 40.0 gallons per minute,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1700 feet South and 1600 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 26, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 26	SW1/4 NW1/4	6.0 acres
	SE1/4 NW1/4	11.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to  $\frac{1}{80}$  of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right allowed herein shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of Williams Creek or any tributary thereof; any depletion will require the well to be shut down, since use of waters of the Williams Creek Basin has been classified only for certain uses by the program statements adopted by the Water Resources Commission.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
