PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11537 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to D. J. Toone (Agent) for John P. Jarnagin, 5050 Takilma Road, Cave Junction, Oregon, 97523, phone 592-3447, for use of the waters from two sump wells,

 $^{\rm for\ the\ PURPOSE\ of}$ Irrigation of 12.5 acres from Sump Well #1 and irrigation of 13.5 acres from Sump Well #2 ,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 6, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 130.0 gallons per minute, being 70.0 gpm from Sump Well #1 and 60.0 gpm from Sump Well #2,

measured at the point of diversion from the SUMDS , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well #1- 1600 feet South and 250 feet East from the North quarter of Section 11; Well #2- 220 feet South and 250 feet East from the North quarter corner of Section 11, being within the Well #1- SW 1/4 NE 1/4; Well #2-NW 1/4 NE 1/4 both of Section 11, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the * A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
