PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11593 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bill T. Small, DBA Rogue Lea Estates North and South Mobile Parks, 414 Currie Lane, Grants Pass, Oregon, 97526, phone 476-9903, for use of the waters from four wells,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for 216 families including the irrigation of lawns or gardens not to exceed 1/8 acre in area per family and community service supplies to include eight R.V. hook-ups, one R.V. wash area, two car wash areas, * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 22, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 333.2 gallons per minute,

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well #1- 1379.51 feet South and 290.40 feet West from the North quarter corner; Well #2- 1457.02 feet South and 134.34 feet West from the North quarter corner; Well #3- 1270 feet South and 1315 feet West from the North quarter corner; Well #4- 1990 feet South and 575 feet West from the North quarter corner, ** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* one laundry area, one club house and one restroom, being 313 gallons per minute for domestic use and 20.2 gpm for community services,

** being within the (Well #1) SE 1/4 NW 1/4; (Well #2) SE 1/4 NW 1/4; (Well #3) NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and (Well #4) SE 1/4 NW 1/4 all of Section 24, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

Appropriation of water under this permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 23, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989 Extended to October 1, 1990 Extended to October 1, 1993, 10-1-93

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990 Extended to October 1, 1993, 10-1-93
