PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11324 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert K. Hanna of 4150 SW Helmholtz Way, Redmond, Oregon 97756, phone 548-6863, for use of the waters from Lonie Well #1,

for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 46.7 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 30, 1984,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 80 feet South and 90 feet West from North quarter corner of Section 12, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 14 East, WM Section 12 SW1/4 NW1/4 30.3 acres
SE1/4 NW1/4 16.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
