## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11585 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Louis J. Scalvini of Route 1, Box 12W, Dayton, Oregon 97114, phone 364-2961, for use of the waters from two wells,

for the PURPOSE of General Nursery and Greenhouse uses,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 19, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 100.0 gallons per minute, being 60.0 gallons per minute from Well #1 and 40.0 gpm from Well #2,

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: #1 - 1750 feet South and 1049 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19; #2 1748 feet South and 880 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, both being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This use shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990.
