PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11635 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Co-Gen Company, a partnership of PO Box 66, Riddle, Oregon 97469, phone 874-2231, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of Industrial uses to include operation of co-generation plant, boiler and cooling water,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 19, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 120.0 gallons per minute,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 950 feet South and 1050 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 10, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM Section 10 NE1/4 NE1/4 Industrial

The use of water shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply from the John Day River allowed under Permit 49760 or to periods of emergency or when flows in the John Day River are turbid, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others,

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
