PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11573 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Schichtels Nursery, by Andrew M. Schichtel of Route 2, Box 69D, Milton-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-4556, for the use of water from one well, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 40.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 40.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 10, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second.

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1240 feet South and 35 feet West from the Center of Section 29, being within the NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

	PRIMARY IRRIGATION
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., Section 29 NE1/4 SW1/4	40.0 acres

	SUPPLEMENTAL
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., Section 29 NW1/4 SW1/4	40.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990.
