PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11668 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond J. Kuenzi of 3707 Cascade Highway N.E., Silverton, Oregon 97381, phone 873-6915, for the use of water from one well,

for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 55.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 25, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1272 feet South and 1375 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 9, being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 9, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W.M., in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of Drift Creek or any tributary thereof. Any depletion will require the well to be shut down, since Drift Creek and its tributaries have been closed to further appropriation, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 $\,$ 70 $\,$.
