PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11670 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Terry R. Behrens of 255 N.E. 12th, Hillsboro, Oregon 97124, phone 640-1888 (home) or 642-8194 (work), for the use of water from one well, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 25.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 29, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 70.0 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: South 44 degrees West a distance of 1010 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 35, being within the NE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 3 West, W.M., in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights, as well as ground water rights of others, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 31, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990.
