### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11706 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Louis J. Scalvini of Route 1, Box 12W, Dayton, Oregon 97114, phone 864-2961, for the use of water from well No. 3,

for the PURPOSE of nursery operations, including containerized nursery stock on 3.36 acres, greenhouse use on 1.34 acres and related nursery uses on 5.79 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 1 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 120.0 gallons per minute, being 120 gpm for containerized nursery stock, 90 gpm for\*

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 2410 feet South and 870 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, being within the SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 19, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M., in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M., Section 19	SW1/4 NE1/4	nursery stock
	SE1/4 NE1/4	nursery stock, greenhouses, related nursery uses

\* greenhouse use and 120 gpm for related nursery uses,

The use of water under this permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights, as well as ground water rights of others, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
