### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11754 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Pacific City Water District of PO Box 88 (34005 Cape Kiwanda Drive), Pacific City, Oregon 97135, phone 965-6491, for use of the waters from two wells,  
for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 27, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 300.0 gallons per minute, being 200.0 gpm from Well 4 and 100.0 gpm from Well 5,

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well #4 - 1.660 feet South and 587 feet East; Well #5 - 728 feet South and 349 feet East, both from the Quarter Corner of Section 30, being within Well #4 - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Well #5 - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, both of Section 30, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

The permit shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 7, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990, 10-1-93

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991, 10-1-93
