PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11795 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Waste Systems Inc. of PO Box 11227, Portland, Oregon 97211, phone 249-8078, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 2.0 acres and industrial uses to include dust control, construction watering and equipment washdown,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 25, 1988,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1200 gallons per minute of water, being 10 gallons per minute for irrigation and 1200 gpm for industrial uses,

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1500 feet North and 200 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 2 North, Range 21 East, WM, in the County of Gilliam.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
