### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use groundwater from ONE ARTESIAN WELL for MUNICIPAL USE AND THE MAINTENANCE OF THE FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM. This permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11773 with a date of priority of JANUARY 4, 1988.

This permit is limited to not more than 2500.00 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING FURTHER LIMITED TO 500 GPM FOR MUNICIPAL USE AND 2000 GPM FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 20, T 1 S, R 39 E, WM;  
290 FEET NORTH & 260 FEET WEST FROM SOUTH 1/4, CORNER,  
SECTION 20.

This permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
