PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from TWO WELLS, TRIBUTARIES OF CHENOWITH CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11715 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 21, 1987, FOR 20.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE AND OCTOBER 18, 1988, FOR 92.0 GPM. The permit is limited to not more than 112.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 20.0 GPM FROM WELL 1 AND 92.0 GPM FROM WELL 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

well (1) SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 1, T 1 N, R 12 E, WM;
300 FEET NORTH & 300 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 1.

well (2) SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 1, T 1 N, R 12 E, WM;
300 FEET NORTH & 900 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

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The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
