is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from ONE WELL WITHIN PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK USE ON 23.0 ACRES The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11731 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 30, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 2, T 6 S, R 1 W, WM; NORTH 60 DEGREES EAST 1000 FEET FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 2.

The permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

If used for field irrigation for nursery stock, such use is not restricted to the defined agricultural irrigation season.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.
