is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from TWO WELLS, WITHIN SILVER CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 265.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 160.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11036 with a date of priority of JULY 25, 1983. The permit is limited to not more than 4.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 2.0 CFS FROM CORRAL WELL AND 2.4 CFS FROM STOCK WELL or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

CORRAL WELL NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 2, T 24 S, R 27 E, WM;
1850 FEET NORTH & 1584 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 2.

STOCK WELL SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 14, T 24 S, R 27 E, WM;
10 FEET NORTH & 1050 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The permit shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior permit for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include air lines and pressure gauges or an access ports for measuring lines, adequate to determine water level elevations in the wells at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep complete records of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 14, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
