PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the groundwater from TWO WELLS, WITHIN UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 24.8 ACRES, BEING 15.0 ACRES FROM WELL (A) AND 9.8 ACRES FROM WELL (B). The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11763 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 27, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 139.2 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 84.2 GPM FROM WELL (A) AND 55.0 GPM FROM WELL (B) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

well (A) SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 30, T 1 N, R 32 E, WM;
1850 FEET SOUTH & 2150 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 30.

well (B) SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 30, T 1 N, R 32 E, WM;
400 FEET NORTH & 1450 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include air lines and pressure gauges or an access ports for measuring lines, adequate to determine water level elevations in the wells at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain weirs, meters or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 14, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
