### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from A WELL WITHIN MOSIER CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 23.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 44.8 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11738 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 12, 1987 FOR 0.29 CFS AND FEBRUARY 4, 1988 FOR 0.56 CFS. The permit is limited to not more than 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 8, T 2 N, R 12 E, WM;  
68 FEET NORTH & 138 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation, in part, the use of water allowed herein may be used first in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies in the Pomona Aquifer, use of which is allowed under earlier rights, provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

**Under the terms of this permit, no water shall be appropriated from the Pomona Aquifer.**

The permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Total: 23.50 primary and 44.80 supplemental acres.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 5, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992. *B 10-1-92*

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
