is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from A WELL WITHIN CLACKAMAS RIVER BASIN for DOMESTIC USE FOR 100 FAMILIES, INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF LAWNS AND GARDENS NOT TO EXCEED 1/4 ACRE IN AREA FOR EACH FAMILY. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application G-11895 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 28, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 11, T 2 S, R 2 E, WM;  
1050 FEET SOUTH & 950 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 11.

The permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
NE SE	11	2 S	2 E
SE SE	11	2 S	2 E

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 12, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.
