to use the waters of A WELL in the ROWENA CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 78.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11722. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1988 FOR 0.23 CFS AND JUNE 13, 1989 FOR 0.75 CFS. The use is limited to not more than 0.98 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 2 N, R 12 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4            0.2 ACRE  
SE 1/4 SE 1/4            7.2 ACRES  
SECTION 6

NE 1/4 NE 1/4            34.5 ACRES  
NW 1/4 NE 1/4            8.1 ACRES  
SECTION 7

NW 1/4 NW 1/4            18.0 ACRES  
SW 1/4 NW 1/4            10.0 ACRES  
SECTION 8

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS PERMIT, NO WATER SHALL BE APPROPRIATED FROM THE POMONA AQUIFER.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 11, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

"B" Extended to October 1, 1992

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
