to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the CHEWAUCAN RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 78.4 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11779. The date of priority is JANUARY 17, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.98 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.49 CFS FROM EACH WELL, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 35 S, R 21 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 2000 FEET NORTH AND 1660 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 30; WELL 2 - 150 FEET NORTH AND 1050 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 17.8 ACRES  
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.7 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 18.8 ACRES  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 32.1 ACRES  
SECTION 30

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 7.0 ACRES  
SECTION 31

TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
