THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of ONE WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11824. The date of priority is JUNE 20, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 2.45 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 14, T 15 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 700 FEET EAST FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 13	SE 1/4 SECTION 14
NE 1/4 N 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 23	W 1/2 W 1/2 SECTION 24

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JANUARY 17, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
