to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the FIFTEENMILE CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 99.98 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11901. The date of priority is MARCH 24, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 1.25 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 14 E, W.M.; NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 1030 FEET NORTH AND 280 FEET EAST; WELL 2 - 330 FEET SOUTH AND 500 FEET WEST; WELL 4 - 230 FEET SOUTH AND 470 FEET WEST, ALL FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

In the event of a request for change in point of appropriation, additional point of appropriation or repair of these wells, the quantity of water to be allowed, together with any other rights from these wells shall not exceed the capacity of these wells at the time of perfection of this right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 40.00 ACRES NW 1/4 SW 1/4 38.18 ACRES SW 1/4 SW 1/4 10.80 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 11.00 ACRES SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
