## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of ONE WELL in the FIFTEENMILE CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 65.4 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12099. The date of priority is MAY 7, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.82 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 1 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 1850 FEET NORTH AND 2440 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 17.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water to be allowed, together with any other rights from this well shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.2 ACRES SE 1/4 SE 1/4 8.4 ACRES SECTION 8

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 12.0 ACRES NW 1/4 NE 1/4 28.5 ACRES NE 1/4 NW 1/4 13.3 ACRES SECTION 17

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure guage adequate to determine water level elevations in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the Department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JUNE 18, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associtated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
