## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of ONE WELL in the KLAMATH RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 42.1 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11966. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 38 S, R 9 E, W.M.; NORTH 88 DEGREES 02 MINUTES 30 SECONDS EAST, 422 FEET EAST FROM C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

LOT 1 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) 0.6 ACRE LOT 2 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) 1.3 ACRES LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4) 12.6 ACRES LOT 9 15.8 ACRES LOT 10 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4) 10.2 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.6 ACRES SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JUNE 25, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
