to use the waters of ONE WELL in the CATHERINE CREEK BASIN for MUNICIPAL USE.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11970. The date of priority is OCTOBER 12, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 5.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 4 S, R 40 E, W.M.; 528 FEET SOUTH AND 3489 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 19.

Within one year of permit issuance, the city shall prepare a report for the Water Resources Commission which specifies the City's water conservation program. The report shall provide an evaluation of opportunities for conservation and include a quantification of losses of water from the systems, an evaluation of the effectiveness and costs of alternative measures to reduce losses, and an implementation schedule for all feasible measures.

Within one year of permit issuance, the city shall prepare a plan/timetable for the Water Resources Commission which shall indicate the steps which the City intends to pursue to obtain a long-term water supply.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

This project was considered and approved by the Water Resources Commission on September 21, 1990.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder will submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before SEPTEMBER 24, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
